## **Review of Surrogacy: Government Position**

I am writing in respect of the England & Wales and Scotland Law Commissions' joint report, *Building Families Through Surrogacy: A New Law*.

Firstly, I wish to thank the commissioners of the Surrogacy Reform Project for meeting with me on the 5<sup>th</sup> November. They provided a very helpful briefing and presentation explaining your recommendations and proposals for a new pathway. I would like to express my gratitude to you and your team for the significant effort that has gone into such a thorough report and draft Bill on a complex and sensitive topic.

I met with the Secretary of State to consider progressing reform in this area. As you will know, the Government has several key priorities that it wishes to progress which will put a significant demand on parliamentary time and resources.

This means that the Government is unable to prioritise surrogacy reform and do not intend to put forward these legislative proposals at the current time. However, we will publish a government response as time allows and will look to consider this issue in the future.
